### REPORT ON REVIEW OF INTERIM CONDENSED CONSOLIDATED FINANCIAL INFORMATION TO THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF GULF INSURANCE COMPANY K.S.C

### Introduction

We have reviewed the accompanying interim condensed consolidated statement of financial position of Gulf Insurance Company K.S.C. ("the parent") and its Subsidiaries (collectively "the Group") as at 30 September 2010 and the related interim condensed consolidated statements of income and comprehensive income for the three month and nine month periods then ended, and interim condensed consolidated statement of changes in equity and the interim condensed consolidated statement of cash flows for the nine month period then ended and explanatory notes. ### 1 ACTIVITIES

The interim condensed consolidated financial information of Gulf Insurance Company K.S.C. (the "parent company") and its subsidiaries (the "group") were authorised for issue by the Board of Directors on 27 October 2010.

The parent company is a Kuwaiti Shareholding Company incorporated in the State of Kuwait in accordance with the Amiri Decree No. 25 of 9 April 1962, and is listed on the Kuwait Stock Exchange. The address of the parent company's registered office is P.O. Box 1040 Safat, 13011 State of Kuwait. The parent company's objectives include all types of insurance, indemnities, compensations and investing its capital and assets in various financial and real estate investments, both locally and abroad.

During the period, Kuwait Projects Company Holding K.S.C. (previously the "ultimate parent company") sold 66,502,800 shares of the Parent Company to Fairfax Financial Holding Limited. Accordingly, the Parent Company is 42.69% (30 June 2010: 67.43% and 31 December 2009: 68.85%) owned by Kuwait Project Company Holding K.S.C and 41.26% by Fairfax Financial Holding Limited as at 30 September 2010.

### 2 SIGNIFICANT ACCOUNTING POLICIES

The interim condensed consolidated financial information of the group is prepared in accordance with International Accounting Standard (IAS) 34, Interim Financial Reporting. The accounting policies used in the preparation of the interim condensed consolidated financial information are consistent with those used in the preparation of the annual consolidated financial statements for the year ended 31 December 2009 except as discussed in the following paragraphs.

### Change in accounting policies

The following new standard is applicable for the Group effective from 1 January 2010.

IFRS 3 (Revised) – Business Combinations and consequential amendments to IAS 27 – Consolidated and Separate Financial Statements. The main changes in the Group's accounting policies are as follows:

- Acquisition related costs are expensed in the consolidated statement of income in the periods in which the costs are incurred;
- Changes in ownership interest in a subsidiary that do not result in a loss of control are treated as transactions between equity holders and are accounted for within equity;
- Equity interest held prior to control being obtained are remeasured to fair value at the date of obtaining control, and any gain or loss is recognised in the statement of income.

The revised standard and new amendments have not had significant impact on the Group's interim condensed consolidated financial information.

The interim condensed consolidated financial information does not contain all information and disclosures required for full financial statements prepared in accordance with the International Financial Reporting Standards. In the opinion of management, all adjustments consisting of normal recurring accruals considered necessary for a fair presentation have been included.

The interim condensed consolidated financial information is presented in Kuwaiti Dinars (KD).

Operating results for the nine month period ended 30 September 2010 are not necessarily indicative of the results that may be expected for the financial year ending 31 December 2010. For more details please refer to the consolidated financial statements for the year ended 31 December 2009.

Also during the period, the Parent Company sold 4,293,785 shares of the treasury shares with a total price of KD 2,132,372 realising net gain of KD 514,720 which has been added to the treasury shares reserve.
